- The bi-monthly Global Environmental Health (GEH) Newsletter provides a look into the research, policy, training, and outreach activities that NIEHS supports abroad. We talk to scientists from around the world to capture their stories and share the unique opportunities and challenges of conducting environmental health research in low resource settings. The newsletter reaches researchers, policymakers, and other stakeholders in more than 175 countries.



- The quarterly Superfund Research Program (SRP) Science Digest features information on SRP grantee research, leadership activities, and technological innovations. We recommend topics for each issue and draft content in plain language suitable for a general audience. We describe SRP-funded research, contextualize findings, and discuss significance. We distribute the electronic newsletter to more than 13,000 people worldwide and post the content on the SRP website.
